What should I wear? Uniforms are required at SJS to show respect for self and others. We ask that the shadow student wear items that will easily blend into our uniform.

Boys: Khaki or navy pants, white or navy polo shirt, belt, white or black tennis shoes
Girls: Khaki or navy pants or navy skirt, white or navy polo shirt, belt, white or black tennis shoes

## What should I bring?

- Lightweight navy sweater or pullover - temperatures in some class rooms may vary.
- A book to keep you busy, just in case there is a quiz or test scheduled in a particular class.
- Completed shadow day permission form - provided by the Director of Mission Advancement.
- Don't worry about bring a lunch - you are our guest, lunch will be provided for all visiting students. If there are dietary restrictions, a student is welcome to bring a lunch.
