

SAINT JAMES CATHOLIC SCHOOL BUS TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

Saint James Catholic School Bus System

Saint James Catholic School (SJS) operates a daily bus for students from the Meade County area. To ride the bus, the student must be enrolled at SJS and have signed up for transportation. The details of the bus route are below.

In the Morning:

- Pick up from Saint Martin Catholic Church (440 Saint Martin Road, Vine Grove, KY 40175) 7:15 a.m.
- Arrive at SJS 7:40 a.m.

In the afternoon:

- Students will depart SJS Approx. 2:40 p.m.
- Bus will arrive at Saint Martin Catholic Church Approx. 3:10 p.m.

Hardin County Bus System

Hardin County provides both AM and PM transportation for SJS students. To be eligible to ride, you must live on a Hardin County bus route. If you are unsure about your eligibility, you may call the bus garage at (270) 769-8965. They will let you know if a bus is available.

In the Morning:

- From G.C. Burkhead and Lincoln Trail Schools and brought to SJS
- From Hardin County Bus stop to SJS (potentially via a school above)

In the afternoon:

- Students will be picked up at SJS by bus and taken to designated location for transfer – either Central Hardin or John Hardin High School

Bethlehem Bus

Bethlehem High School provides AM transportation for SJS students. Students are picked up at Saint Christopher Church in Radcliff or Saint Brigid Church in Vine Grove.

In the Morning:

- Pickup from Saint Brigid and brought to SJS 6:50 a.m.
- Pickup from Saint Christopher and brought to SJS 7:00 a.m.
