We do expect to be at capacity in some grade levels next year, so it will be very important for our current families to complete enrollment packets for returning students by noon on February 23 to save their spot. This is also the time for current families to complete an application for any siblings they wish to attend SJS next year. We have already received more than 60 applications for new preschool through 8th grade students for the 2024-2025
