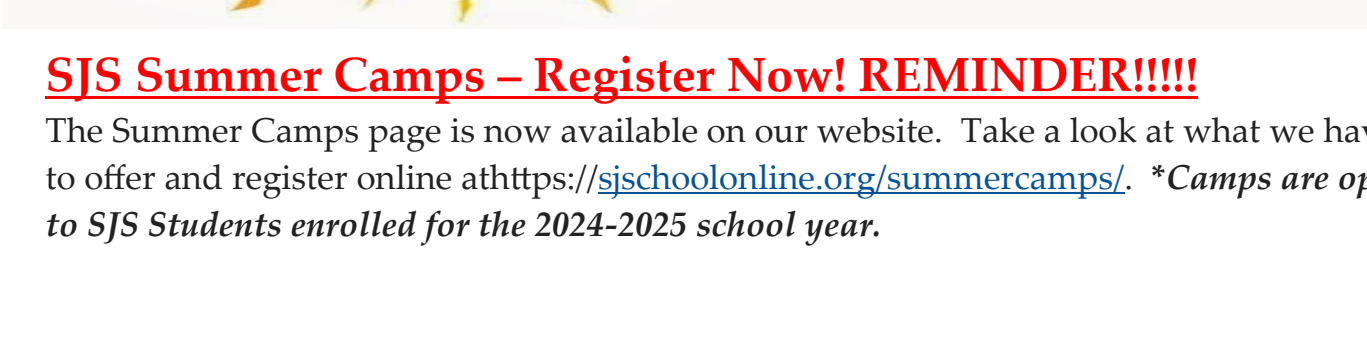

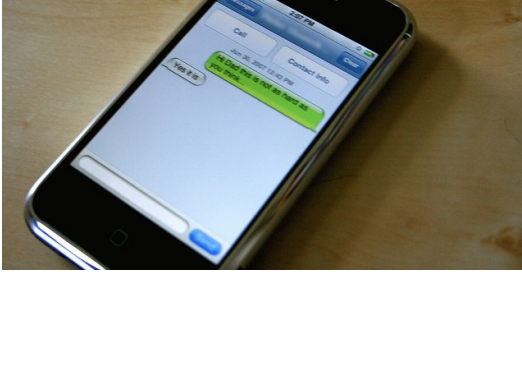

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Layering prevention strategies can be especially helpful when:

Your symptoms are getting better	+	You are fever-free (without meds)
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Then take added precaution for the next 5 days

Reminder: Anyone who has contact with our students (coaches, chaperones, volunteers, room parents, etc.) needs to complete Safe Environment Training and have a background check. An initial live training is required followed by an online refresher every five years. Don't miss this opportunity to attend a session right here in E'town if you need this training!
