
May 8: Annual International Mass

Reminder: Anyone who has contact with our students (coaches, chaperones, volunteers, room parents, etc.) needs to complete Safe Environment Training and have a background check. An initial live training is required followed by an online refresher every five years. Don't miss this opportunity to attend a session right here in E'town if you need this training! No sign up required, however it is recommended that you show up a little early to complete background check paperwork.

Per Archdiocese policy, due to the sensitive nature of the topics covered in the training, children 16 and under, to include infants, WILL NOT BE PER-MITTED.


You will receive a certificate of completion for church records after the training.

The Archdiocese requires Safe Environment Training and a Background Check every 5 years. After that time, an online refresher course can serve to renew the training and the background check form may be completed and sent to Laurie Bradford at <u>lbradford@stjames-etown.org</u>, delivered in person to the parish office, or sent through the mail to St. James Catholic Church, ATTN: Safe Environment Coordinator, 307 West Dixie Avenue, Elizabethtown, KY 42701
