

# Uniform Code

## Frequently Asked Questions



### 1. Where can I find the uniform guide?

### 2. Where am I allowed to get uniform items?

We have 3 exclusive vendors that are approved and updated on all school uniform apparel: St. John/Etown, Choice/Bardstown, Lands’ End/online.

### 3. What will happen if my child arrives at school not wearing what they’re supposed to?

Policies and procedures are outlined in the handbook. The first week will be a very forgiving grace period. Most uniform violations beyond the first week will be addressed by the administration. In most cases, a student will need to rectify the dress code violation before attending their regular classroom.

### 4. What about shoes...do they have to be solid black or solid white?

All Tennis Shoes must be predominantly white or black. Accents and logos are allowed if they are grey, white or black. Thus, a student would be in code even if they have a white shoe with black or grey logo stripes on the shoe.

### 5. Does my child need to wear a belt with the school uniform?

If your child is PreK through 2nd...NO! All grades 3rd – 8th grade (boys and girls) are required to wear a belt with uniform pants and shorts.

### 6. What if my child has a 3/4 zip from Gerald/Dukes that has the school logo on it? Can they wear it in the classroom?

No...all uniform items (shirt, shorts, pants, skirt, sweater, etc.) MUST be from one of our 3 approved vendors. Coats and outerwear items with logos from Gerald/Dukes are usable outside of the classrooms.

### 7. What if my child is cold in the classroom and likes to wear a sweatshirt or 3/4 zip with the school logo from previous years?

All uniform items must be in line with the dress code and with items from one of our 3 approved vendors (shirt, shorts, pants, skirt, sweater, etc.).

### 8. Are coats & outerwear REQUIRED to have the school logo embroidered on it?

Not if it is being placed into a locker/cubby during school hours, but you can certainly add the logo at your preference. A logo may be added to coats, bags, etc. at St. John, Choice or Lands’ End.

### 9. What items can my child wear that I’ve purchased from Gerald, our online spirit store vendor?

Gerald Printing is approved to supply SJS spirit wear. Your child can wear any spirit wear item (old or new “fun” designs that do not include the school SJS logo or an older logo) on designated spirit days (typically most Fridays).

### 10. On “out of uniform” days, can my daughter wear the shorts/skirts like from Lululemon?

Yes, however, the shorts, dresses or skirts may not be shorter than 2” above the knee for all students small or tall.
