UNIFORM CHECKLIST AT A GLANCE

The uniform code has been explicitly written in order to help parents and students avoid confusion about what to wear. It is designed to give our students a look that is neat, clean, consistent, age-appropriate, and befitting the image of a Catholic school. The uniform will be strictly enforced. All unapproved variations will result in a violation. A full explanation of what to expect with continued disregard for the school's uniform is outlined in the SJS handbook possibly resulting in the parents being called to the school to bring appropriate attire. If the school is unable to reach the parents, the school reserves the right to address the violation as it deems fit, and in some cases, to remove the student from the classroom until such time as the parent can be reached.

Girls

- Uniform approved plaid Mass skirt required 4th – 8th
- Uniform approved plaid Mass jumper required K - 8th
- Uniform approved peter pan dress shirt with SJS logo required K – 8th
- Uniform approved oxford with SJS logo required 4th – 8th
- D Belt required with pants and shorts **3rd 8th**
- Uniform approved PE pants/shorts/t-shirt with logo required 4th – 8th
- Uniform approved pants/shorts depending upon season
- Uniform approved skirt/skort optional for PreK 8th
- Uniform approved jumper optional for grades
 PreK 3rd only
- Uniform approved polo dress with SJS logo optional for grades PreK – 3rd only
- Uniform approved polo with SJS logo (peter pan or straight collar)
- lacksim U Uniform approved socks
- **D** Uniform approved shoes

Boys

- Uniform approved oxford with SJS logo required for Mass **PreK-4 8th**
- D Belt required 3rd 8th
- Uniform approved PE pants/shorts/t-shirt with SJS logo required 4th – 8th
- Uniform approved pants/shorts depending upon season
- □ Uniform approved polo with SJS logo
- Uniform approved socks
- Uniform approved shoes

Optional

- Uniform approved sweater, fleece or pullover with SJS logo
- Uniform approved Bike shorts, leggings, or tights
- □ SJS spirit wear may be worn on Fridays with uniform bottoms

Uniform Code Frequently Asked Questions



1. Where can I find the Uniform Guide?

The easiest access is on our website: sjschoolonline.org/parent-student-resources/. The Uniform Guide with recent updates can be found in the "Documents" section. The guide is also located in the school handbook.

2. Where am I allowed to get uniform items?

We have 3 exclusive vendors that are approved and updated on all school uniform apparel: St. John/Etown, Choice Uniforms/Bardstown, Lands' End/online.

3. What will happen if my child arrives at school not wearing what they're supposed to?

Policies and procedures are outlined in the handbook. The first week will be a very forgiving grace period. Most uniform violations beyond the first week will be addressed by the administration. In most cases, a student will need to rectify the dress code violation before attending their regular classroom.

4. Do shoes need to be solid white, or solid black?

All Tennis Shoes must be predominantly white, black or grey. Accents and logos are allowed if they are white, black or grey. Thus, a student would be in code even if they have a white shoe with black or grey logo stripes on the shoe.

5. Does my child need to wear a belt with the school uniform?

If your child is PreK through 2nd...NO. All grades 3rd – 8th (boys and girls) are required to wear a belt with uniform pants and shorts.

6. Are coats & outerwear REQUIRED to have the school logo embroidered on them?

No. Coats and outerwear must be stored in a cubby or locker during school hours, so a logo is not required. A logo may be added at St. John, Choice Uniforms, or Lands' End if the family should desire.

7. What items can my child wear that I've purchased from our online spirit store vendor?

The spirit store vendor is approved to supply SJS spirit wear. Your child can wear any spirit wear item (old or new "fun" designs that do not include the school SJS logo or an older logo) on designated spirit days (typically most Fridays).

8. Are there requirements for "no code days"?

Yes. Please refer to the Uniform Guide and/or handbook for dress requirements for "no code days".
